(Registration opens January 16, 2023)

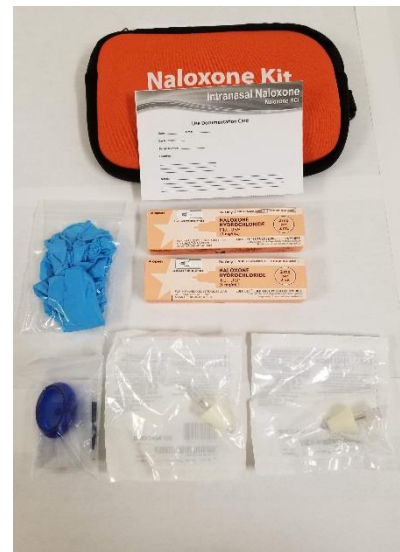
Time: 6:00 PM-7:30PM
