Resolution Authorizing the Sale of Vehicles No Longer Fit for Public Use and Whose Values are Less Than the Town's Bid Threshold, at Private Sale Without Advertising for Bids.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36(6) provides that a Town may sell personal property not needed for public use, the estimated fair value of which does not exceed the applicable bid threshold, at private sale without advertising for bids; and

WHEREAS, as set forth in the attached certification of Kevin Murphy, and the certification of Scott Macfie with respect to the 1989 Jeep used by the Police Department, the vehicles listed below are not fit for public use and have either minimal value or scrap value; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kearny, Hudson County, New Jersey that:

The Department of Public Works (and with respect to the 1989 Jeep, the Police Department) be and hereby are authorized to sell the vehicles listed below at private sale without advertising for bids, but following the solicitation of at least 3 quotes in accordance with a procedure approved by the Chief Financial Officer.
